

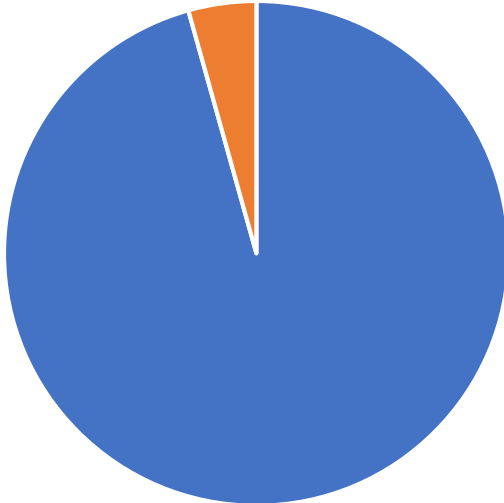

Sponsor a Classroom Program 2018 Evaluation Results

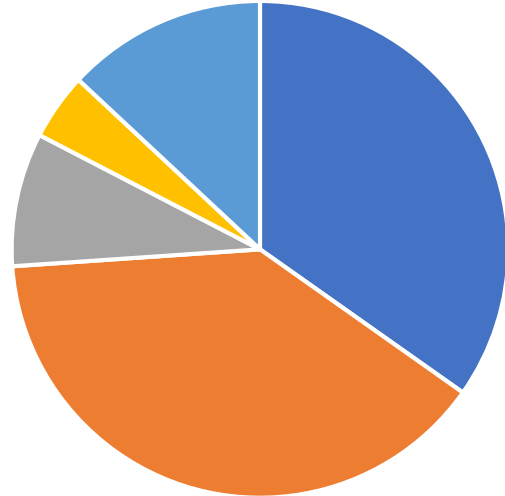
This evaluation was sent to 155 educators who participate in our Sponsor a Classroom program. 23 responded (15%)

Role in Education



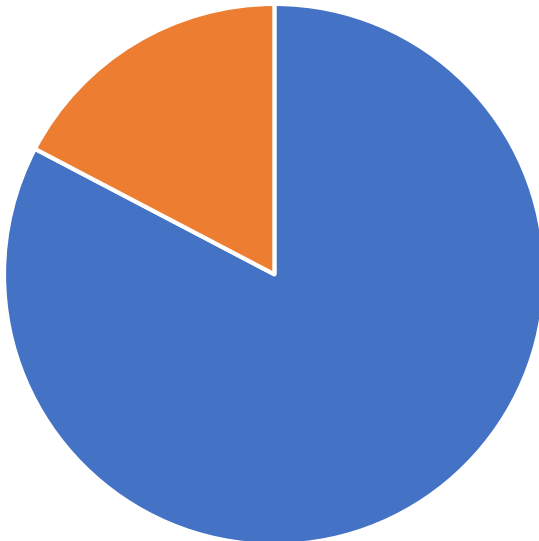

Grade Level



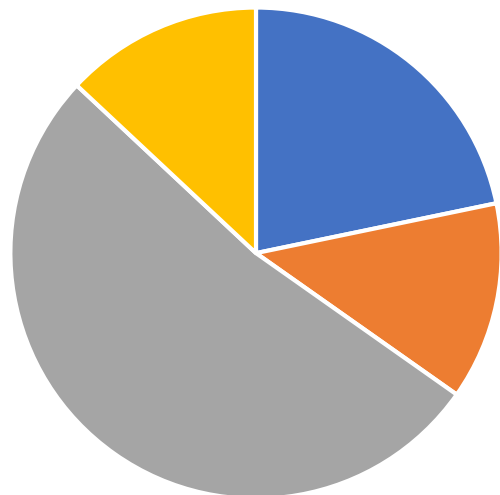

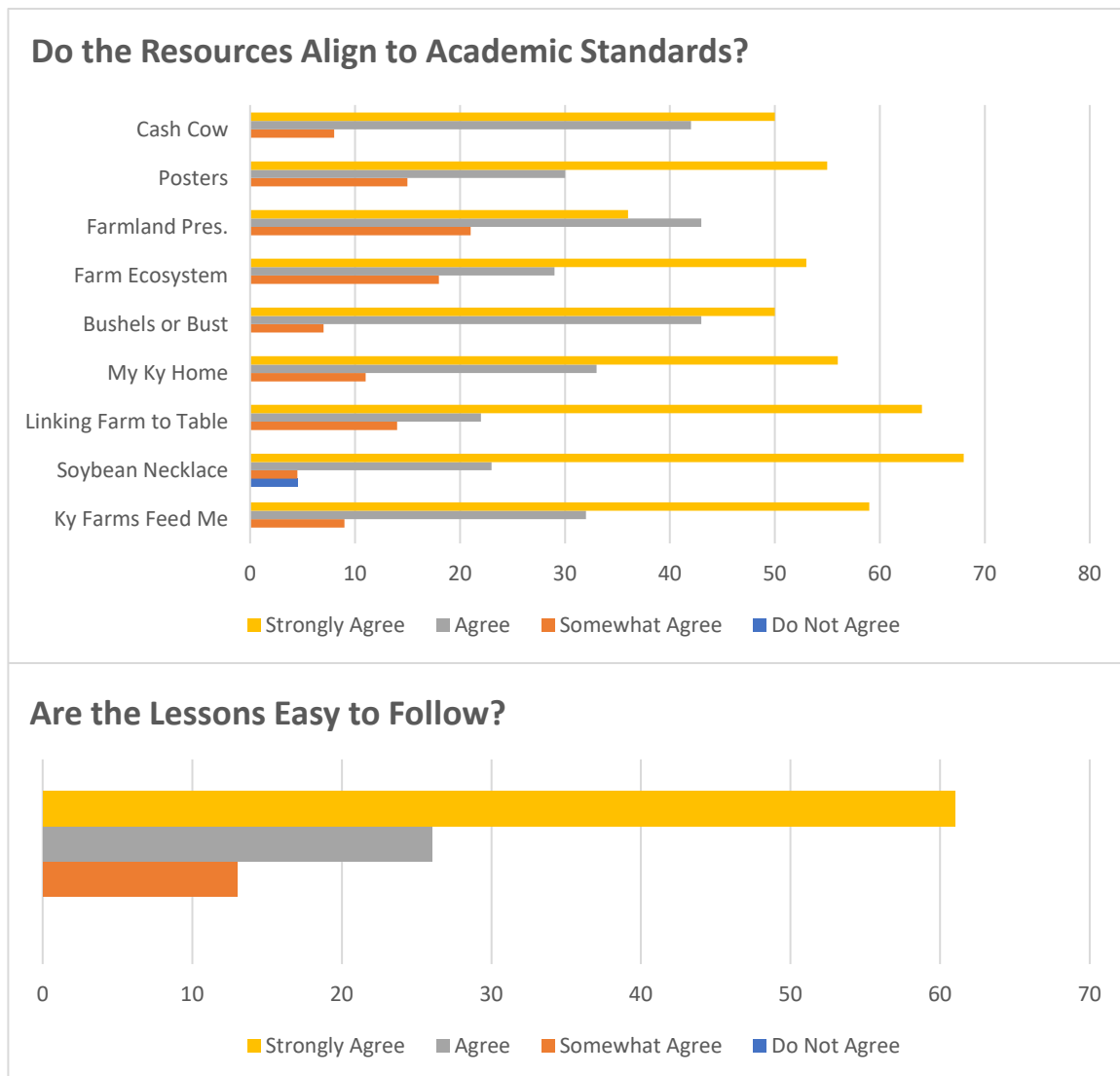
How Long Have You Been Using Our Resources?

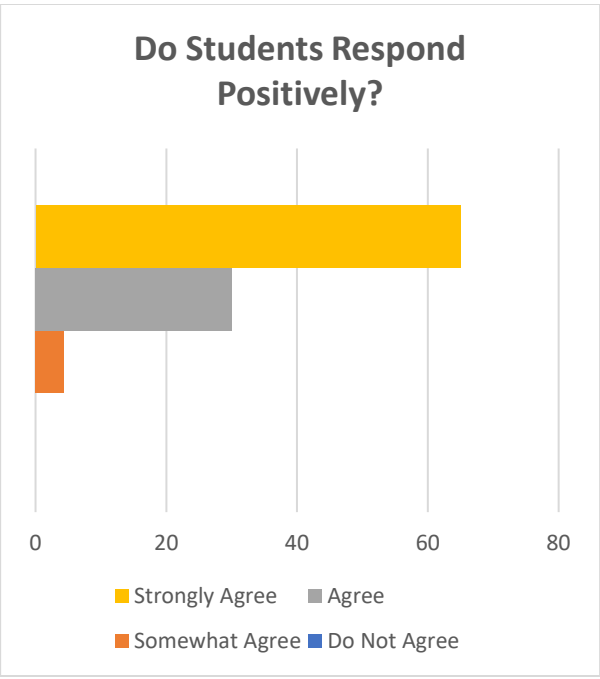
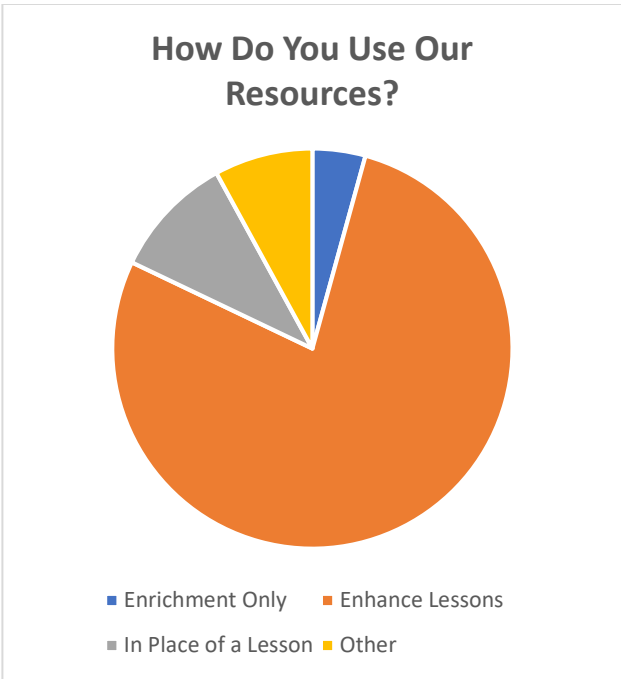

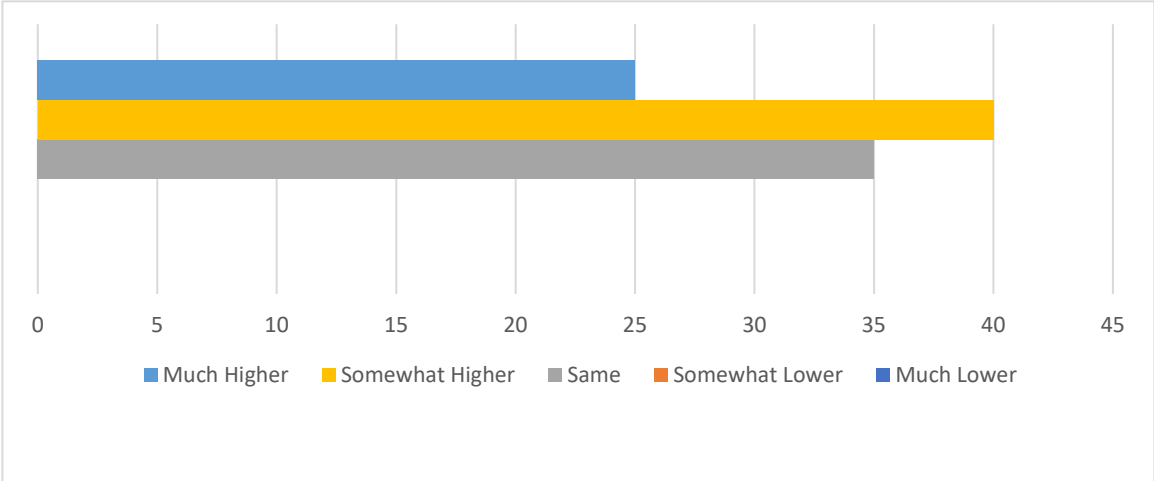
How Often Do You Use Our Resources?

- Kentucky Farms Feed Me Virtual Field Trips & Lessons – 91% have used them, 55% have used more than once, 4% use it weekly, 34% use it monthly
- Soybean Germination Necklace Activity – 95.6% have used it, 4% use it monthly
- Linking Farm to Table – 91% have used it, 17% have used it more than once in the school year
- My Kentucky Home Provides What I Need – 80% have used it, 25% have used it more than once in the school year
- The Farm as an Ecosystem – 84% have used it, 12% have used it more than once in a school year
- Farmland Preservation – 53% have used it, 12% have used it more than once in a school year
- Bushels or Bust – 63% have used it, 21% have used it more than once in a school year
- Agriculture Posters – 95% have used them, 8% use them daily, 46% use them more than once in the school year
- Cash Cow – 50% have used it, 8% use it monthly
- Books – 95% have used them, 38% use them more than once in the school year

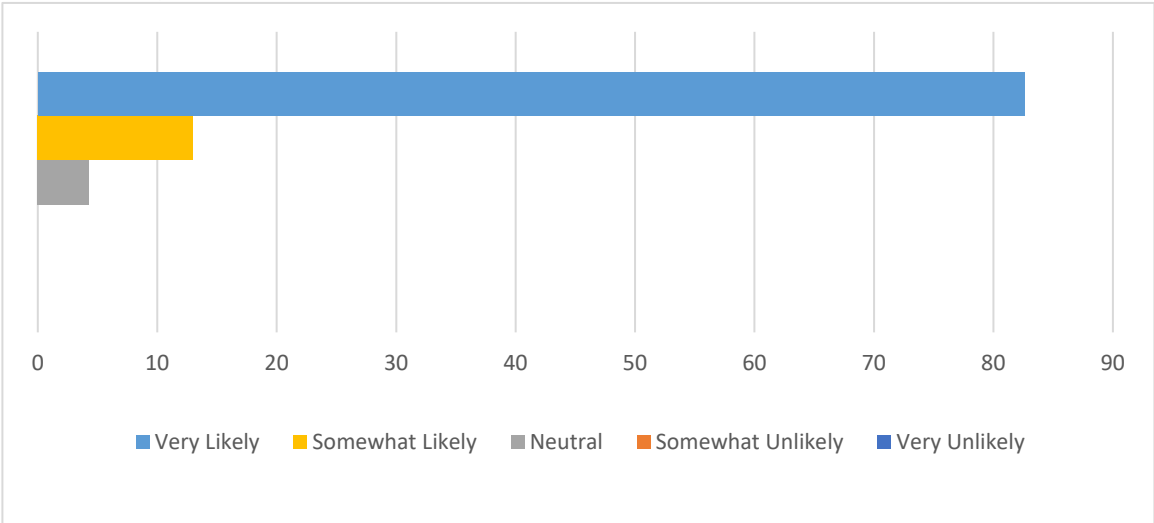


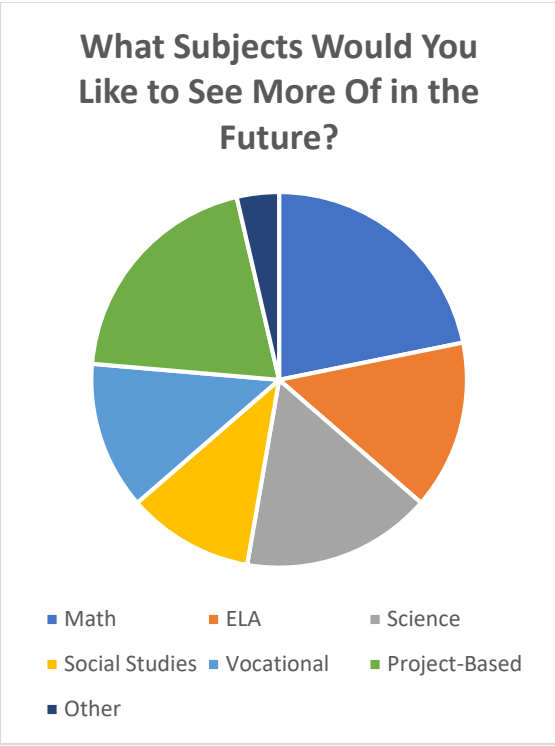
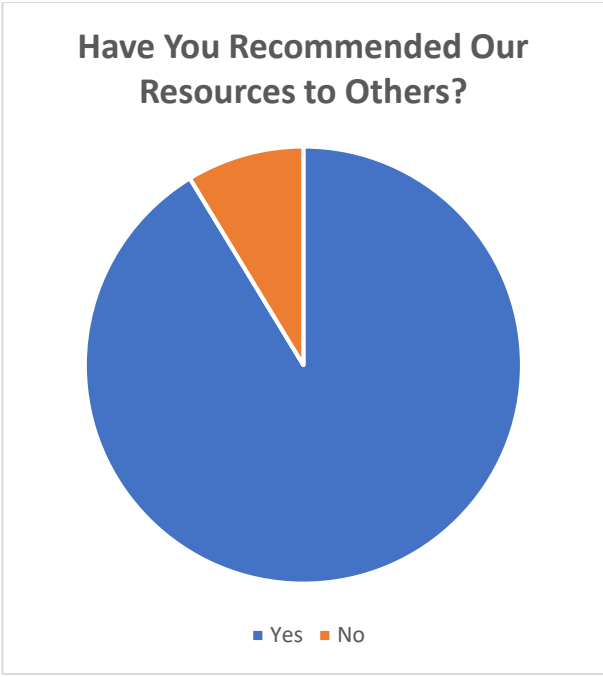


Do You Believe Our Resources Help Students Perform Better on Standardized Tests?
